Conditions and Application Procedure

Please read carefully and retain for your records

1. Registration onto our courses is free and in filling out the form you are under no obligation to take up a course.
2. On receipt of your application FUTURE STAGE ARTISTS (FSA) will contact you within 5 working days to inform you of a start date for your course.
3. In the event that a start date cannot be set within this time, you will be placed on a waiting list until there are sufficient students for the next course to begin. You can contact us at any time to find out the status of your application.
4. Please let us know as soon as possible if any of the details/availability you have given become subject to change.
5. If there is availability on a similar course to that which you have applied for, FSA may contact you to find out if you might be interested in transferring.
6. Based on your application and in consultation with you, FSA will select a course level appropriate to what we believe to be suitable to you. If, once you have started, you are unhappy with the course, we may be able to change you to a different class. Please note that such a change may not be possible right away.
7. As soon as you are confirmed on a new course, we will email you with the dates, times. At this point you will be required to pay a deposit of \$40 (payable to FUTURE STAGE ARTISTS). The deposit payment is non refundable but is offset against your first class fees.
8. All evening courses run from 7pm-10pm. Weekend workshops run from 9:30am – 6:30pm. Classes take place at our studio: 50 Bukit Batok st23 MIDVIEW Building #07-12
9. The maximum number of students per course will be limited to 3persons.
10. Full payment of the balance of the course fees will be payable on or before the beginning of your first class. If you have any difficulty making such a payment, please let us know in advance and you can arrange for payments to be split.
11. If, for whatever reason, you are unable to complete the course or miss certain classes, once paid, fees are non refundable.
12. If any classes are cancelled or cut short by either FSA or your teacher, you will be entitled to an extra class (or part thereof) to cover for any time lost.
13. FUTURE STAGE ARTISTS accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to property or injury to persons that may occur in the premises or in the common parts of the building.
14. Subject to demand and time availability of the students and teacher, once a course has come to an end, some classes may be able to continue for another term or until further notice.
